Dear Governor Mifflin Parents,

Recently the Governor Mifflin School District Board of Directors updated the district's Electronic Device Policy #237. The policy is available for your review on our district web site. As a result of this action, the district administration discussed revisions to the procedures for policy enforcement.

Beginning March 8, 2010, the Governor Mifflin School District will begin enforcing the district's Electronic Device Policy, as follows:

Offense	Consequence	Returned to:
1	Confiscation, Verbal Warning	Student
2	Confiscation, Detention	Parent
3	Confiscation, Saturday Detention	Parent
4	Confiscation, ISS	Parent
5 +	Confiscation, Progressive Discipline	Parent

If, at any time, between Offense 1 through Offense 5+, a student refuses to hand over the electronic device to the person in authority requesting the item, the violation will be forwarded to police for appropriate action.

We wish to remind parents of the disruptive nature of personal electronic devices within the school setting. The above enforcement procedure is designed to bring consistency throughout the district.

We encourage you to discuss with your sons and daughters both appropriate and inappropriate use of electronic devices. As always, we appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we continue in our efforts to provide your children with the best education possible.
