

**PRESS RELEASE – STATEMENT BY JONATHAN P. RIBA, COUNSEL FOR  
GOVERNOR MIFFLIN SCHOOL DISTRICT ON THE MATTER ANDREA  
COLEMAN-HILL V. GOVERNOR MIFFLIN SCHOOL DISTRICT, CIVIL ACTION  
NO. 09-CV-5525**

As has been previously reported, the Governor Mifflin School District has been sued by a current employee, Ms. Andrea Coleman-Hill, who alleges the District racially discriminated against her. The District categorically denies all claims of racial discrimination and looks forward to proving its case in Court.

Unfortunately, in the process of litigating this case, legal counsel for Ms. Coleman-Hill, Robin J. Gray, Esq., circumvented the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and obtained internal District documents in a clearly inappropriate manner. Accordingly, the District was forced to file a Motion for Sanctions because the actions of Ms. Gray severely prejudiced the established legal rights of the District. On November 4, 2010, the Honorable Lynne A. Sitarski sanctioned and admonished Ms. Gray for her conduct and granted the District's request that its attorney fees be reimbursed by Ms. Gray.

The District also vehemently denies Ms. Gray's prior public comments in which she stated that the internal documents contain evidence of discrimination or that the District willfully did not produce them. Such statements are complete falsehoods.
