GOVERNOR MIFFLIN ALUMNI RELIVE SCHOOL LUNCH EXPERIENCE

SHILLINGTON, PA, DECEMBER 2010 - On Tuesday, December 21, seven alumni from the Governor Mifflin Class of 2001 and 2002 will present a \$500 donation to Governor Mifflin in support of its food services program. In return, the alumni have one request: to return to Governor Mifflin High School and share one more school lunch together.

Class of 2001 alumnus, Joshua Bugay, said that he and his friends have often reminisced about their favorite school lunch foods since graduating from Governor Mifflin. Their nostalgia led them to come up with the idea of presenting a cash donation to the food services program in exchange for an opportunity to taste some of their favorite foods again. Each alumnus in the group contributed to the cash donation.

GM Food Services director, Jenelle Himmelreich, said she was surprised when she was contacted by Bugay. "I've never heard of such a thing; I thought it was a joke," she said. Himmelreich has not yet decided how she will use the money, but one idea on the table is to distribute the amount among those students who just miss the cutoff for qualifying for free and reduced lunch benefits.
