Motion by Dunkelberger and second by Koestel to Approve the **Setting of a Special Meeting date for the Reorganization of the Governor Mifflin Board of School Directors**, on Monday, December 5, 2011, 7:00pm, in the Education Center Board Room

Ms. Alicia Spencer, Mohnnton, requested to address the Board. Ms. Spencer is the mother of a Middle School student who received straight A’s in all subjects except one. Because he got a B- in a major subject, he was prohibited, by school policy, from making Honor Roll status. Ms. Spencer noted that Governor Mifflin’s Honor Roll criteria is different than other school districts and requested that the Board explain the rationale behind Mifflin’s policy. The Board agreed to take the issue into consideration and investigate the history of the Honor Roll system.

After review of the Work Meeting Agenda was complete, Mr. Ulrich gave several announcements. First, he informed the Board that, since Mr. Brent Worley was retiring as the District’s representative to the BCIU Board, we need to appoint a replacement to serve out the remainder of the term through June 30, 2012. Mr. Ulrich offered to serve in this capacity if there no other volunteers, and approval will take place at the November 21, 2011 meeting. Mr. Ulrich then announced information for upcoming Board orientation programs and meeting schedules for the remainder of November and December, 2011.

Since Mr. Ulrich will be out of town and unable to attend the November 21<sup>st</sup> meeting, he took a moment to thank Pam Cala, John Summers and Brent Worley for their service to the Board, the District and the community. He noted that they have all done a great job and he's sorry to see them go. He was pleased to be able to say that all three were always willing to do whatever he asked of them.

Upon Adjournment of this Meeting, the Board held a brief **Executive Session** for the discussion of Personnel matters.
