BRECKNOCK PTO EVENTS & COMMITTEES

All Kids Belong: Help organize and assist in a day of teaching 2nd grade students about disabilities.

Art Show (Spring): Assist art teacher in displaying artwork.

Book Fair (Fall & Spring): Help set up and run sale; assist children in book selection.

Box Tops for Education: Assist with the collection and counting of General Mills box tops.

Display My Art: Assist with collecting and distributing orders.

Fall Family Fun Night: Assist with event.

Fall Fundraiser: Kidstuff (Sept/Oct): Assist with collecting and distributing orders.

Food for Thought: Help collect and count Redner's receipts and Campbell's labels.

Garden Day: Weed school gardens and plant flowers with children.

Gingerbread House Night (Dec.) - Assist with the set-up and clean up of event.
