<b>American Education Week</b>	<b>November</b>	Greet, direct and assist relatives visiting school
<b>Baked Goods</b>	<b>As needed</b>	Provide baked goods for various activities
<b>Box Tops</b>	<b>As needed</b>	Assist coordinator with collecting, clipping and bundling box tops
<b>Civil War Reenactment (Grade 5)</b>	<b>May</b>	Run a game or assist with Civil War Day activities
<b>Display My Art Fundraiser</b>	<b>September/October</b>	Assist coordinator with collecting and submitting artwork and orders and/or distribution of orders
<b>Field Days</b>	<b>May/June</b>	Measure and record event results
<b>Family Fun Night</b>	<b>February</b>	Assist coordinator with organizing this family fun event for GMIS
<b>GMIS Art Show</b>	<b>March</b>	Assist art teacher in hanging/displaying students Art Show projects
<b>GMIS Book Fairs</b>	<b>August/January</b>	Set up fair inventory; work as cashier; assist children in book selection
