Event Descriptions:

Rolling Silverware

Students will be timed and judged on how accurately they can place a fork, spoon, and knife into a cloth napkin and roll the silverware in the napkin.

Bus & Set Table

Students will be timed and judged on how quickly and accurately they can remove items from a table, clean the table and set a new place setting.

Mail Sort

Students will be timed and judged on how accurately they can sort pieces of mail with different names. Students will need to pay attention to last and first names and sort as much as they can in a given time.

Stocking Shelves

Students will be timed and judged on how many labels they can accurately sort. They will need to look for details on the label or of the product. This skill will also require hand eye coordination hanging the items.

Assembly Task

Students will be timed and judged on how many items they can assemble in the given time.

Filing cards in ABC order

Students will be timed and judged on how many cards can be filed in a card box during the given time.

Cleaning Surfaces

Students will be judged on how quickly they can clean a dirty, marked window and/or wooden surface. Judging will be based on using the proper cleaners, how well the surfaces are cleaned, and disposing of proper trash.

Fold/Hang Personal Laundry

Students will be timed and judged on how many clothing items they can fold and hang correctly. Dress pants, dresses and collared shirts must be hung on a hanger while all other clothing must be folded neatly.

Sweeping

Students will be given a broom, dustpan and trash can and will have to sweep a designated marked area. There will be obstacles in the area that will need to be moved while sweeping. Student will need to put their “dirt” into a trash can and place the broom and dustpan back where they started to finish the task.

Paper Packets

Students will be given a sample of collated papers and have paper clips on the top left corner. Students must complete as many paper packets as possible in the time given. They must have the papers in the correct order and make sure the paper clip is in the correct location.

Bagging Groceries

Students will be timed and judged on how well they can bag groceries as if working at a grocery store. Placement of groceries, how many items in a bag, and weight of the bags will all be judged.

Bed Making: (2 participant team event)

Partners will work together to remove bedding from a bed to be “washed” and replace with “clean” bedding. They will need to know how to use a fitted sheet, flat sheet, comforter, and pillow cases. Partners will be judged on how much they could get done in the time given, if they used “hospital corners” with the fitted sheet, if the bed was neatly made and if they worked on the task as a team. **Remember this is a partner event**
