Elementary School Sample

School Name Elementary School supports active parent involvement and parent participation in the education of their children through the federally funded Title I reading program. Children benefit when home and school share responsibility and are active partners in their education.

The School Name Elementary School, which is served under Title I, shall:

- ✓ Hold parent meetings twice a year, once each spring and fall. Parents will be informed of these educational programs and involvement opportunities.
- ✓ Offer meetings for parents to provide materials and training to work with their children at home.
- ✓ Share information about assessments used to measure student progress and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet.
- ✓ Provide opportunities for parent-teacher conferences and give reports to parents on their children's progress.
- ✓ Ask for parent input regarding the Title I Parent Involvement Policy and Home/School Involvement Compact
- ✓ Inform parents of opportunities for volunteering and visiting at school.
- ✓ Contact parents to discuss progress/concerns.
