<i>Activity</i>	<i>Month</i>	<i>Description</i>
American Education Week	November	Greet, direct and assist relatives visiting school. As little as 60 minutes or the whole day.
Baked Goods and Other Foods	As Needed	Provide goodies for various activities
Box Tops for Education	Ongoing	Assist coordinator with collecting, clipping and bundling Box Tops. This can be done at home or with a friend.
Scholastic Book Fairs	August/January	Set up and tear down fair inventory; work as cashier; assist in book selection. As little as 30 minutes or the entire event.
6th Grade Graduation	June	Set up and serve refreshments - approx. 1 hour(5 th grade parents)
Redner's Receipts	Ongoing	Assist coordinator with collecting and totaling receipts for rebates.
Staff Appreciation Luncheon	April	Baked goods, set up; serve food; clean up
Tyson A+ Labels	Ongoing	Assist coordinator with collecting, clipping and bundling Labels. Can be done at home or with a friend.
Gifts 'N Things	November	Assist coordinator in distributing sales materials, collecting orders and payments, or distribution of orders (as much or as little time as you are able to give. Some things can be done at home, some are done at school.)
Cabin Fever	February	Assist coordinators with planning and set up. Obtain prizes, coordinate with crockpot and cupcake contestants, serve food, call Bingo, etc. (as much or as little time as you are able to give. Some things can be done at home, some are done at school.)
