Voter registration campaign earns Governor's Civic Engagement Award for Governor Mifflin High School

Who: Robert Torres, Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth and Governor Mifflin High School students and staff

What: Governor Mifflin students will be honored for their quantifiable action during the past election season. Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth Robert Torres will recognize Governor Mifflin social studies teacher Michael Kurtz and several of his students with the Governor's Civic Engagement Award.

The honor is a collaborative effort between the Pennsylvania Department of State, Pennsylvania Department of Education, and Inspire US. High schools across Pennsylvania were challenged to increase voter registration among their eligible student population. Governor Mifflin students achieved "gold level" status for the award by helping register more than 85% of eligible voters within the high school.

Acting Secretary Torres will recognize the students involved in the voter registration effort, and address the entire graduating class, during a commencement practice at Santander Arena.
