Students are encouraged to listen to announcements at both GMHS and BCTC for updated information pertaining to these calendar adjustments.

BCTC Transportation Guidelines

Governor Mifflin High School students attending BCTC will attend the morning session only. All BCTC busses will depart the high school at approximately 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 11:00 a.m. BCTC students will have their **lunch period at GMHS**. Daily lunch account deposits must be dropped off in the high school main office no later than 10:00 a.m.

Due to the fluctuation between the school calendars, the following transportation parameters will be in place for this school year:

Normal school day – both BCTC and GMHS in-session:

Students will be mailed, under separate cover, “Bus Information” postcards which will include pertinent information regarding bus stops and bus numbers.

- All BCTC students will depart GMHS at approximately 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 11:00 a.m.

GMHS is in-session, and BCTC has NO school or operating on a delay bell schedule of any kind – students do not have to report to BCTC:

Students have two options:

- In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until their classes begin **11:05 a.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
- Or, report directly to the high school no later than **11:05 a.m.** Students must find their own transportation; the district will **NOT** provide bussing for students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.

BCTC is in-session, but GMHS has NO school:

On these specific days, transportation to and from the high school will be provided by district busses; BCTC will provide transportation to and from the career centers. In November, alternative “Bus Information” postcards will be mailed; these cards will indicate modifications to bus stops and bus numbers for these specific days.

- All BCTC students will depart GMHS at approximately 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 11:00 a.m.

BCTC is in session, and GMHS is operating on a delay bell schedule per the timetable below – students do not have to report to BCTC

Two-hour bell delay schedule, students have two options:

- In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until their classes begin **12:05 p.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
- Or, report directly to the high school no later than **12:05 p.m.** Students must find their own transportation; the district will **NOT** provide bussing for students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.

Three-hour bell delay schedule, students have two options:

- In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until their classes begin **12:11 p.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
- Or, report directly to the high school no later than **12:11 p.m.** Students must find their own transportation; the district will **NOT** provide bussing for students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.

Both BCTC and GMHS have a two-hour delay – students do not have to report to BCTC
